Seat belt lock from CG-Lock

Some readers will be able to remember when seat belts were first introduced. With those original "static" belts, you put it on and pulled it tight, and it stayed tight and held you in the seat. Then the inertia-reel seat belt was introduced, and with it came freedom to move in the seat until the reel locked if you moved too much.

However, there are times when you're driving that you feel you need to be held more firmly in the seat and not be allowed to move about, especially when driving off-road on rough terrain. One option is to fit a full harness belt, another is to fit the CG-Lock.

This device lets you remove as much slack from the lap section of the seat belt as you want, whenever you want, using the integrated release lever. The lap section stays tight but the CG-Lock allows the shoulder section of the seatbelt to remain free so that you can move and easily reach switches, etc, or turn your upper body in the seat.

This design is ideal for off-roading, where you want to be held at the hips to avoid "submarining" on steep descents, but still want upper body movement to look out of the window to avoid obstacles.

The CG-Lock is a palm-size (75 mm x 60 mm x 24 mm) mechanical device made of high-grade stainless steel. It fits to the seat belt buckle with two Allen screws (an Allen Key is provided) and fits over the belt by a slide clasp. It can be removed in seconds and leaves no



damage to your seat belt.

The CG-Lock fits standard three-point lap-and-shoulder harnesses with single-pass belt tongues and costs £44.99 including post and packing (but you should check for overseas postage rates). It comes with a full money-back guarantee if you are not completely satisfied, or if it turns out not to be suitable for your vehicle's seat belts.
